



Bronte Public School has installed the largest solar power system on a primary school in the Eastern Suburbs, with the help of the Solar my School program.

The school received funding from the Waverley Council Small Environment Grants program, as well as the NSW Department of Education to help finance the system. Annually the system will:



Save **33%** on facility's energy bill



Produce enough power equal to running **220 computers** or **8 homes**



Reduce carbon emissions by **39 tonnes**



Equivalent to taking **14 cars** off the road

Location:	Bronte
Size of system:	30 kW
Estimated bill savings:	\$6000/yr
Estimated energy savings:	44,000 kWh
Simple payback:	2 years (after funding)
