



Vaucluse Public School is now partly powered by sunshine with a 20kW solar power system. The school received funding from the Woollahra Council Environmental Grants, the Purryburry Trust and the NSW Department of Education.

Annually the 50 solar panels will produce clean green energy to power the school's learning facilities:



Save **25%** on facility's energy bill



Produce enough power equal to running **144 computers** or **5 homes**



Reduce carbon emissions by **26 tonnes**



Equivalent to taking **9 cars** off the road
